Physical Literacy Financial Assistance Application (includes: evening programming, summer camp).

Please note, the Physical Literacy Financial Assistance Program is only able to provide support to a limited number of qualified applicants and financial assistance is determined by Government of Canada low-income cut-off. All information provided will be held in the strictest of confidence.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the subsidy program, you must be living within 25% of the low-income cut-offs as set by the Government of Canada.

Financial Assistance is valid for **one year** from the approval date.

This chart shows the maximum household income to qualify for the Financial Assistance Program. You will receive either 100% coverage or 50% coverage for program fees based on your household income. There is a limited amount of assistance available, therefore, not all qualifying applications will be approved. Final decisions will be emailed to you within one (1) week of applying.

Approved applicants can receive **up to \$250/season** (fall/winter/spring) of assistance per participant, and **up to \$500** of assistance per participant for summer camp.

KidSport

KidSport provides grants to kids from families facing financial barriers so they can participate in registered sport programs and experience the lifelong benefits of a season of sport. KidSport Ontario provides grants of up to \$250 per eligible kid, per year (January 1st - December 31st) towards sport registration fees.

If the child needs equipment, we will make a referral to a partner agency. Grants are intended to be used for sport registration fees; travel and competitions are not eligible for funding.
